2009 FEE SCHEDULE FOR HERNDON CENTENNIAL GOLF COURSE APPROVED BY TOWN COUNCIL *No Fee Increase for Town Residents*

Herndon, VA (February 25, 2009) – The Herndon Town Council has approved a fee schedule for the Herndon Centennial Golf Course’s 2009 season that calls for no fee increases for town residents and nominal increases for non-residents.

Additionally, the council approved a new seven-day annual pass for residents and non-residents, as well as a “pay as you go” rate for resident senior and junior golfers of \$15 per 18 holes and \$11 per nine holes.

“Maintaining current rates for residents is directly in line with the council’s 2027 Vision tenets – ‘Exceptional Service’ and ‘Our Renowned Amenities,’” said Gene Fleming, director of Golf for the town. “The Mayor and council members have been clear in their direction that town residents should have a distinct benefit when playing golf at Herndon Centennial.”

The new rates, which go into effect on March 15, call for a weekday, 18-hole in season rate of \$19 for town residents, \$32 for non-residents. Weekend rates for 18-holes are \$27 for residents and \$45 for non-residents. For a full listing of rates, visit www.herdongolf.com.

The Herndon Centennial Golf Course is operated by the Town of Herndon as an enterprise fund, with personnel, operating, capital and debt services expenditures fully covered

by generated revenues. The course is consistently ranked among *Golf Digest Magazine's* "Places to Play."

The Town of Herndon was incorporated by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Virginia on January 14, 1879. Located in western Fairfax County, Herndon is the 3rd largest town in the Commonwealth and is home to more than 23,000 citizens. Businesses located within the Town of Herndon, which range from high tech enterprises to entrepreneurially-owned establishments, employ approximately 25,000 people. *Business Week Magazine* has named Herndon one of the nation's "Best Affordable Suburbs."
