TOWN OF HERNDON APPOINTS DIRECTOR OF FINANCE

Herndon, VA (February 16, 2017) – The Town of Herndon has named Jennie A. Tripoli as director of Finance. Tripoli replaces Mary K. Tuohy, who retired in December 2016 after 22 years as the department’s director.

In her new post, Tripoli will be responsible for direction of the town’s financial affairs to include successful execution of the adopted annual budget; analysis and counsel related to fiscal decisions by the Town Council; management of financial processes to include inter-governmental grants, procurement, and fiscal policy execution; adherence to and preparation of accounting reports related to annual audit(s) and professional organization standards; and management of Department of Finance personnel.

Tripoli will report directly to Acting Town Manager Bill Ashton and will serve as a member of the town’s management team. “Jennie brings an exceptional mix of experience, expertise and financial acumen to her new role,” said Ashton. “The Town Council, management team and I will all benefit from her fiscal guidance. I look forward to welcoming Jennie to our leadership team.”

Tripoli comes to the town following more than six years of service as the assistant director of Finance for the City of Fairfax, where she oversaw department operations, implemented a purchasing card program for the city, and served as acting budget manager. Previously, she had worked in positions of increasing responsibility in the private sector, to include tenures at Fannie Mae, Navigant Consulting and Arthur Andersen. She holds a bachelor of science in accountancy from the American University and is a certified public accountant.
