Town of Herndon Parks & Recreation Department Celebrates Completion of Bready Park Tennis Court Renovation

The Town of Herndon Parks & Recreation Department is excited to announce the successful completion of the highly anticipated tennis court renovation project at Bready Park. This project marks a significant milestone in enhancing recreational opportunities for the Herndon community and visitors.

The renovation included the installation of new fencing, the application of a ProBounce® surface, and the addition of four pickleball courts. The Bready Park Tennis Courts now boasts a total of four pickleball courts and five tennis courts, with three of the tennis courts currently housed in our temporary indoor tennis facility.

With the rising popularity of pickleball, the Herndon Parks and Recreation Department is dedicated to ensuring ample opportunities for everyone to enjoy these newly upgraded facilities. The following options are available to the community and visitors:

Court Reservations: Individuals can reserve a court for \$10 per hour by visiting bit.ly/HPR-courtReservations or by calling 703-435-6868. Each user is limited to one reservation per day, with a maximum of one hour per reservation.

Open Play Pickleball: Scheduled sessions for players of all skill levels will be held on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 10 am to 12 pm, as well as Tuesdays and Thursdays from 12 pm to 2 pm, and Sundays from 10 am to 2 pm.

The courts are available for use from sunrise to 10 pm daily, accommodating both reservations and drop-in play.

"We are pleased to publicly open the newly renovated Bready Park Tennis Courts, featuring the innovative ProBounce® surface which will add many years of use to the courts and enhance player comfort with the cushioned surfacing for both tennis and pickleball enthusiasts. The addition of pickleball courts is a testament to our commitment to meeting the diverse recreational needs of our community," stated Cindy Roeder, Director of the Town of Herndon Parks & Recreation Department.
