

## **Hunter's Creek Bridge Replacement Update**

The timeline for replacement of the Hunter's Creek Bridge, the pedestrian bridge that accesses the Sugarland Run trail from Hunter's Creek pool and tennis courts, is extended due to sensitivities of working in a wetland area, which requires an Army Corps of Engineering Permit, as well as working in a floodplain. The new estimate is for construction to begin this fall, with estimated completion in spring 2025. Once completed, the new bridge will be a reinforced fiberglass structure on new foundations. In the meantime, while the bridge is closed, residents may continue to use Cavendish Street or Runnymede Park entrance to access trails. Thank you for your patience as we navigate this project with respect for its environs.

Town Manager Bill Ashton is preparing a proposed FY 2025 Budget to present to the Town Council on April 1, 2024, for their consideration and adoption. The proposed budget will recommend funding allocations for town services and programs as well as future

initiatives the town may undertake. The proposed budget will be posted online, at <u>Herndon-va.gov/Budget</u>, and a proposed budget summary brochure will be mailed to all households and businesses.

Now is the time to let the Town Council know your priorities. Which programs and services do you value most? Which would you like to see expanded, or reduced? Are there initiatives you'd like for the town to explore? Following release of the proposed budget, the council will hold public hearings on April 9 and April 23 to solicit public comment. All meetings begin at 7pm and are held in the Council Chambers at 765 Lynn Street.
