





Project Location





Project History

Fall 2023

- Identified the safety concern and closed the bridge at the beginning of October 2023
- Immediately retained consultant support to survey, design, and permit the bridge
- Contacted Fairfax County for informational and contract support

Winter 2023/24

- Completed preliminary designs and cost estimate
- Contracted with bridge manufacturer
- Began Town and other required approvals (Army Corps, Special Exception, Site Plan)

Spring 2024

- Conducted contractor negotiations
- Finalized permitting (Army Corps, Building Permit)
- Allocated funding

Existing Bridge



Project Overview


- 1. Removal of existing unsafe bridge and abutments
- 2. Removal of abandoned pipe
- 3. Stabilization of stream banks
- 4. Restoration of stream channel
- Regrading the bridge site
- 6. Installing new bridge and foundations
- Install new trail connections and refurbishing trail surface

Proposed Construction Schedule

Contractor Notice to Proceed: June 5, 2024

Contractor On-site: July 15, 2024

Duration of Construction:
 6 weeks, weather dependent

Final inspections:
 First 2 weeks of September 2024

Tentative date of opening: Mid September 2024



Construction Impacts

- Site Access:
 - Cavendish Street (equipment, materials, and other deliveries)
 - Hunters Creek Pool & Racquet Club (short duration)
- Work Hours:
 - 7:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. on weekdays (quiet hours before 8:00 A.M.)
- Deliveries and Parking:
 - Cavendish Street cul-de-sac
 - No residential driveways will be blocked
 - No materials or equipment storage will occur within the street

Construction Impacts

- Signs will be posted on trails
- Contractor will open Hunters Creek trail after work hours
- Redwing Trail closed at all times
