Attorney Needed for Architectural, Historic District Review Boards

The town is in immediate need of a member of the Virginia State Bar to serve on the Architectural Review Board (ARB) and Historic District Review Board (HDRB). The attorney position serves a vital role in considering exterior modifications to structures

within the town. The ARB has jurisdiction over all structures except detached single-family homes, while the HDRB has jurisdiction over structures in the Historic District.

Members serve three-year terms; residency within the Town of Herndon is required. Members receive \$3,000 per year for their service on the boards. In-person meetings are on the first and third Wednesdays of each month at 7p.m.

Avoid Using Too Much Fertilizer

Only Rain Down the Drain

An illicit discharge is any discharge to the storm drainage system that is not rain. If you see an illicit discharge in the storm drainage Works advises that using too much fertilizer or other lawn care products can cause water pollution through runoff in local waterbodies and the Chesapeake Bay. Perform a soil test to determine proper fertilizer application rates, and please use non-toxic products, slow release, or organic fertilizers.
