HERNDON HIGH SCHOOL HOMECOMING PARADE CELEBRATES “OUT OF THIS WORLD” ON NOVEMBER 9

Herndon, VA – The Herndon High School Homecoming Parade is set to take place this Saturday, November 9th, kicking off at 9:30 am. The event promises to be a celebration of school spirit, community pride, and a trip “Out of this World”.

Spectators are invited to line Elden Street between Locust Street and Lynn Street to cheer on the marching band, class floats, enthusiastic cheerleaders, spirited elementary students, young athletes, and community organizations that will be participating in this festive procession.

The parade route will extend along Elden Street from Locust Street/Sterling Road to Lynn Street, providing ample opportunities for everyone to be part of the excitement.

To ensure the safety and smooth flow of the event, please take note of the following street closures and parking restrictions on Saturday morning:

6:00 am to 1:00 pm

- Town Hall Parking Lot: Permit Parking Only.

6:30 am to 10:00 am

- Locust Street from Elden Street to Center Street.

8:00 am to 1:00 pm

- All side streets with access to Elden Street closed, with homeowner access only. This includes Grace, Main, Peachtree, and Ferndale from Vine Street (enter at Center and Vine Streets); and School, Spruce, Lillian Chase, Nathaniel Chase, and Grace from Locust Street (enter at Center and Locust Streets).

8:30 am to 1:00 pm

- Lynn Street between Elden and Center Streets; including access from Nachman Way, Dyer Court, and Station Street.
- Station Street municipal parking lot entrance at Station Street closed – use Center Street

9:00 am to 1:00 pm

- Elden Street from Sterling Road/Locust Street to Monroe Street
- Center Street from Vine Street to Locust Street
- Elden Street from Sterling Road/Locust Street to Monroe Street

To facilitate the re-routing of Fairfax Connector, the north side of Pine Street is designated as No Parking from 6:30 am – 1 pm.
